

# C4K Income Eligibility

Youth from low income households, as defined by the [U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development](#) (HUD), are eligible to apply for C4K's free programming. Low income is described as 80% of the area median family income though additional factors can impact the final limit calculation (for more information see: [FY 2024 Low-Income Income Limits Calculation](#)<sup>2</sup>). For the current C4K fiscal year, the limits from HUD's previous year are used due to differences in fiscal year calendars.

For C4K eligibility, we use the HUD income limits for the Charlottesville Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) which includes Albemarle County, Fluvanna County, Greene County, Nelson County, and the City of Charlottesville.

Effective: July 1st, 2024 - June 30th, 2025
